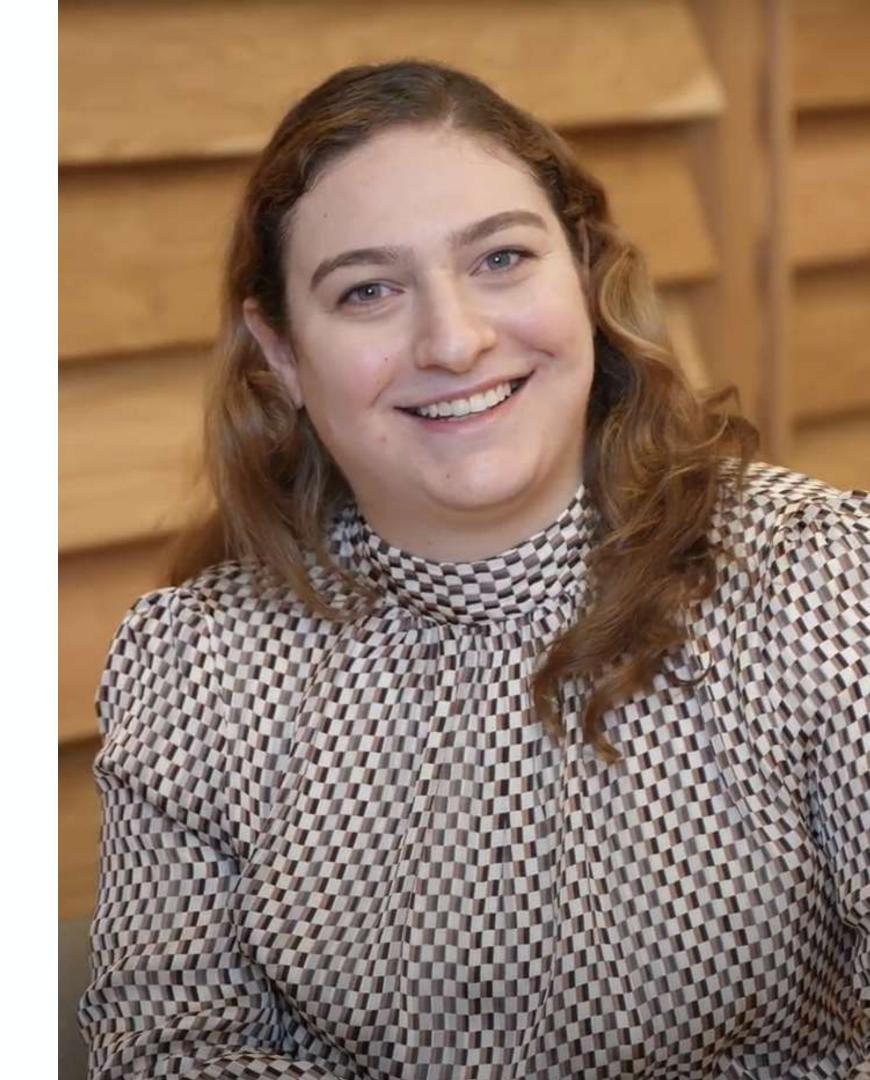

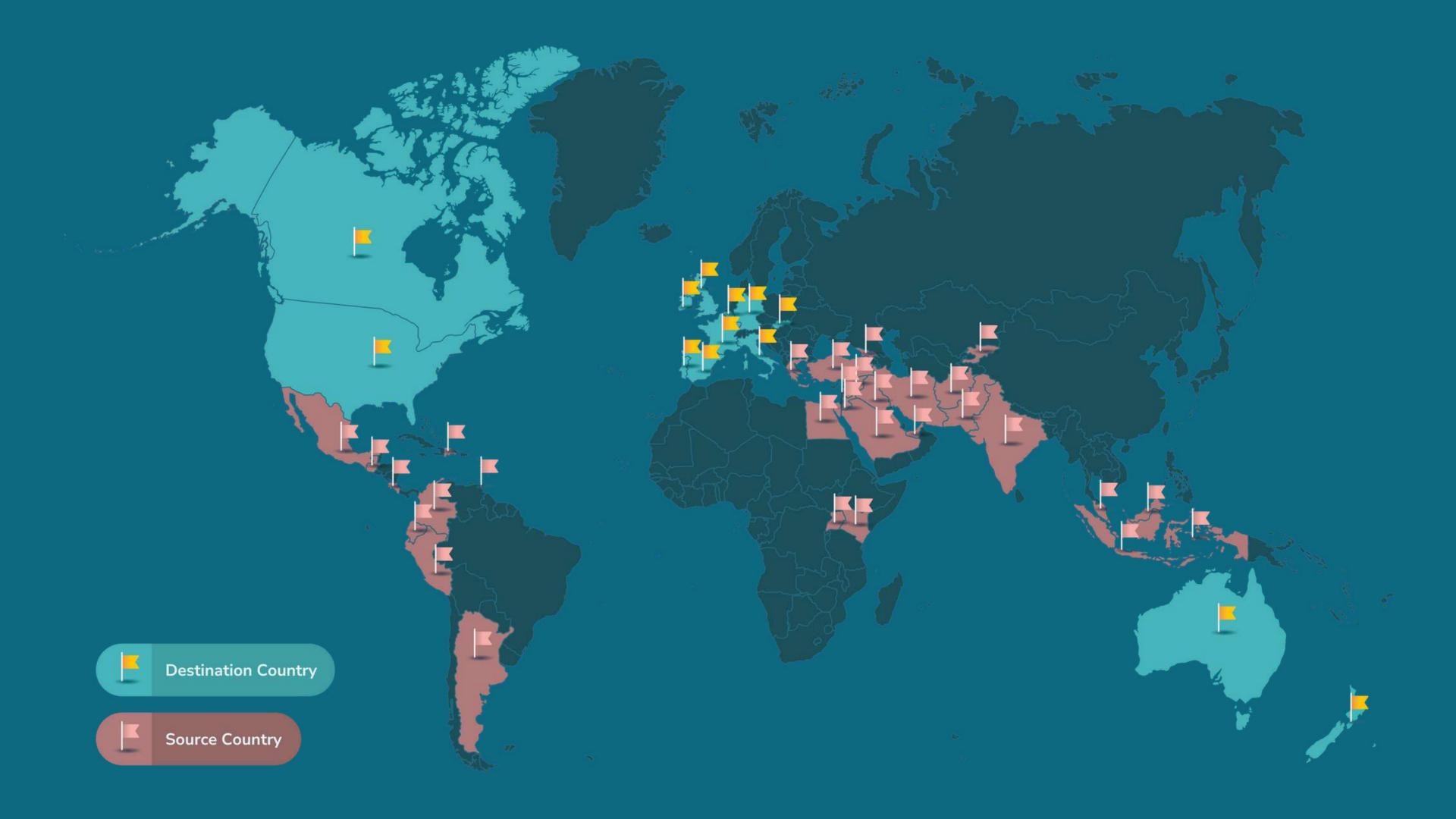

Our Process

1

Hiring

Employer selects role(s) they need filled. We provide a shortlist of suitable candidates.

We facilitate remote or inperson recruitment (e.g. interviews, skills validation, etc.).

Employer issues job offer(s), TBB supports informed decision making. 2

Immigration

We require employers to use a licensed immigration representative for ethical recruitment.

Fragomen, our preferred provider, offers a discounted rate.

3

Relocation

We help the employer prepare for the arrival of their new recruit.

We connect employees with local settlement services so they and their families receive support.



Post-arrival

We provide support via regular check-ins with employees and their direct manager for 12 months.

The Economic Mobility Pathways Pilot (EMPP)

A part of Canada's Immigration Levels Plan

Workers and **Entrepreneurs**

Humanitarian

Family Reunification

A Permanent Resident Visa

The EMPP makes **job-ready** refugees more accessible to employers by reducing common barriers and processing most applications within 6 months.

- > TBB is an EMPP Trusted Referral Partner
- > No recruitment effort requirements
- Candidate must have English or French fluency and at least one year of previous work experience
- Employer must provide a full-time, nonseasonal job offer
- Government fees and biometrics waived; candidates also have access to loans



Costs

For less money and about the same amount of time as the Temporary Foreign Worker Program, Canadian employers can hire **permanent employees** for your business needs.
